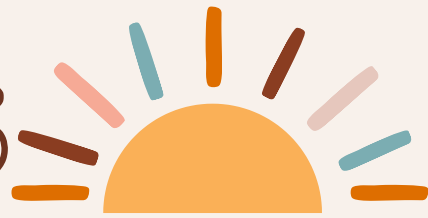

With the warmer months upon us, it's time to switch out those back up clothes to more weather appropriate ones for the warm weather. Please be sure to switch out your child's extra belongings bag from long sleeves, sweaters, and pants, to t-shirts, shorts, and some longer sleeved shirts and pants in case we have a cooler day. Summer Time Weekly Themes

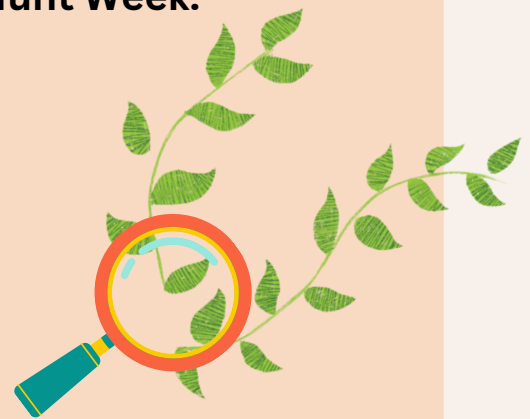


August 5th - 9th Around The World Week:
