With our Winter Concert around the corner, the children will be doing lots of practicing and preparing for their songs being performed. We ask that the children attend consistently in the time leading up to the Winter Concert. We will be practicing so that the children feel comfortable and well prepared for their concert. Children can dress in red or green for the concert and are welcome to wear a Christmas hat (reindeer ears, elf ears, elf or santa hat, etc.) To ensure that families are comfortable enjoying the performance and that our fire regulations and capacity are met, we will be holding the two classroom concerts separately; each child is allowed a two guest limit at the Winter Concert. Closer to the dates of the concert there will be an RSVP sheet placed at the door where families can provide us information on who will be attending. Also there will be as a section where you can inform us if you're not able to take your child home right after the concert; this will help us provide the children with smooth transitions and also gives us an idea of what numbers will be like afterwards so we can plan accordingly for the remainder of the day. The concert will be taking place at 3:00PM.
